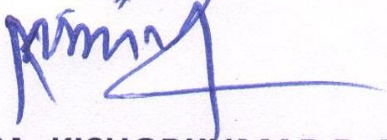

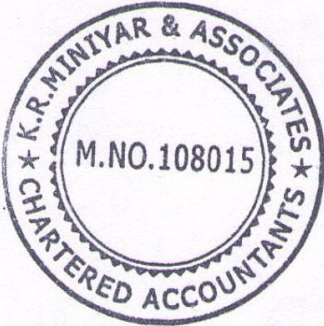

1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Unaudited Consolidated Financial Results of Bilcare Limited (the "Holding Company") and its subsidiaries (the Holding Company and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group") for the quarter ended June 30, 2022 and year to date April 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022 (the "Statement"), being submitted by the Holding Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").
2. This Statement is the responsibility of the Holding Company's Management and has been approved by the Holding Company Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 (Ind AS 34) "Interim Financial Reporting" prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended, read with the relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). 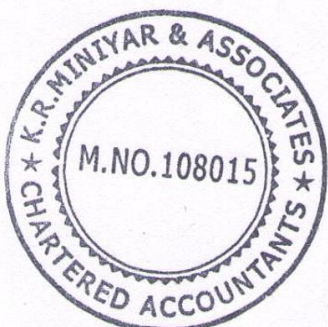

Based on our review and procedures performed and as stated in Para 3 above and based on the consideration of the review reports of the other auditors referred to in Para 6 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) specified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended, read with the relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
6. The accompanying Statement includes the unaudited interim Ind AS financial results and other unaudited financial information, in respect of:
- One subsidiary, whose interim Ind AS financial results reflect total revenues of Rs. 110.47 crore, total net profit after tax of Rs. 1.54 crore, total comprehensive income of Rs. 1.57 crore for the period from April 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022, before giving effect to the consolidation adjustments, as considered in the Statement whose interim financial results and other unaudited financial information have been reviewed by other independent auditors.
 - Five subsidiaries, whose interim Ind AS financial results reflect total revenues of Rs. 5.50 crore, total net profit after tax of Rs. 0.24 crore, total comprehensive income of Rs. 2.42 crore for the period from April 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022, before giving effect to the consolidation adjustments, as considered in the Statement whose interim financial results and other unaudited financial information have not been reviewed.

These unaudited interim Ind AS financial results and other unaudited financial information have been furnished to us by the Management and the Board of Directors of the Holding Company and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of the above subsidiary, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and such other unaudited financial information and the procedures performed by us as stated in Para 3 above and the unaudited financial results of the subsidiaries not review.

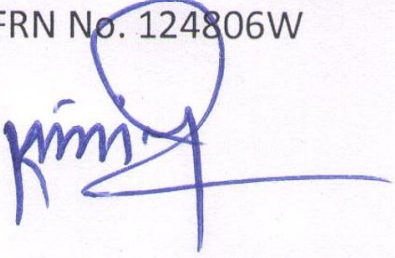
